Premier Cru Beaune Clos de la Mousse 2018


This is elegant, succulent and packed with cherry and black currant fruit, wrapped in spice and toasty oak accents. It hints at floral and mineral elements too, as the long aftertaste winds down on the finish. It's solidly built and complex.



93 Points

Premier Cru Beaune Grèves Vigne de L'Enfant Jésus 2018

Intense and tightly wound, this red displays a laser beam of cherry and berry fruit, with an underlying mineral element and steely structure. It's concentrated and long yet needs time to reveal all its facets.



91 Points

Premier Cru Beaune du Château Rouge 2018

Lush and opulent, offering ripe cherry, plum and sweet spice flavors. Firm tannins, some from the oak, line the finish, so give this time to integrate.



93 Points

Grand Cru Chambertin-Clos de Bèze 2018

Flavors of black cherry, black currant, earth and spice are draped onto the elegant frame of this red. Its structure lends grip on the compact finish, while the oak is pretty dominant now.

Chambolle-Musigny 2018

Silky and exuding violet, blackberry and black currant, this red is about as alluring as a young Burgundy gets. It firms up on the finish with refined, cocoa powder tannins. Vibrant and long too.

Chassagne-Montrachet 2018


Lean and tense, its lemon, apple and vanilla flavors propelled by the vivid acidity; that cut extends the finish, leaving a mouthwatering impression.

Premier Cru Nuits-Saint-Georges Les Cailles 2018

This is lush and pure, offering black cherry, black currant and toasty oak notes. Excellent length too, but this is mostly about the expressive fruit.



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
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Premier Cru Pommard 2018

Though rich, there is a dense, beefy quality to this red, showcasing the black cherry, plum, earth and iron flavors. Not a layered, complex style, yet with the weight and power for winter stews and braised meats.

Premier Cru Volnay Les Caillerets 2018

Lush in texture and balanced on the soft side, this red displays black cherry, blackberry, violet and earth flavors. Terrific harmony and a long, complex finish of fruit and mineral. Will be approachable in the short term.
