More elegant aromas of red currant, cherry and soft earth nuances are trimmed in a whisper of oak toast. The supple and relatively round medium weight flavors are not especially concentrated but do compensate with offering a lovely texture before concluding in a youthfully and mildly austere finale.

## Gevrey-Chambertin 2017

An admirably discreet oak influence is present on the relatively high-toned red berry fruit scents that express additional breadth in the form of earth, humus and underbrush. The mid-palate of the middle weight flavors isn't quite as dense as that of the Vosne though there is slightly better precision to the saline, youthfully austere and bitter cherry-inflected finish.
