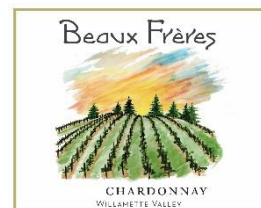




Willamette Valley Chardonnay 2018

95+ Points

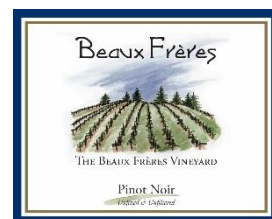
The 2018 Chardonnay Willamette Valley opens with toast and pie crust nuances with lush quince paste and peach fruits, plus nuances of hazelnuts and spring honey. The medium-bodied palate is silky, expansive, rich and toasty, with intense fruits tempered by mineral streaks and lively acidity, and it finishes very long.



Beaux Frères Vineyard Pinot Noir 2018

94+ Points

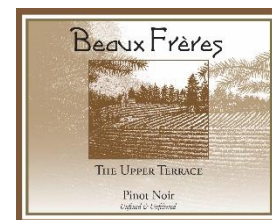
The medium ruby-purple colored 2018 Pinot Noir The Beaux Frères Vineyard opens to lush rhubarb, cranberries and loamy earth with layers of blood orange, tea leaves, charcuterie and flowers. The medium-bodied palate offers broody, concentrated fruits with fine earth and spice accents, with a seamless, silky frame and lifted finish.



Upper Terrace Pinot Noir 2018

95+ Points

The 2018 Pinot Noir The Upper Terrace takes time to come out of its youthful shell. It slowly opens to clay, blackberries and blueberries with touches of fragrant earth, tar and violets. The palate is medium-bodied and silky with full, layered fruits and bright, energetic acidity, and it finishes very long and lifted.



Belles Soeurs Pinot Noir 2018

Medium ruby in color, the 2018 Pinot Noir The Belles Soeurs has pure scents of cranberry, dusty earth and charcuterie with top notes of citrus peel and iodine. The medium-bodied palate is pure and expressive, lifted and fresh, with a silky texture and long, ethereal finish.
