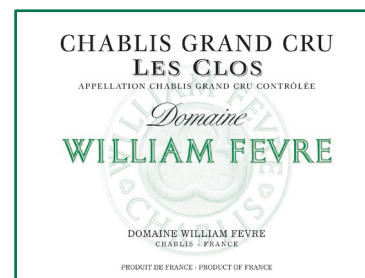


Grand Cru Les Clos Domaine 2020

17.5++ Points

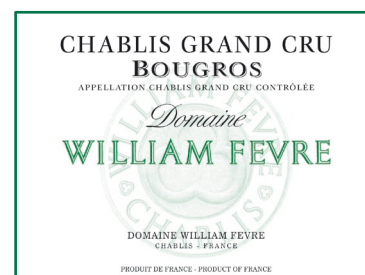
Intense nose – more so than the Preuses or Bougros. Solid concentration and obviously a long life with good acidity. A real mouthful in which the fruit just about matches the astringency but it would be shame to drink it too young...



Grand Cru Bougros Domaine 2020

17 Points

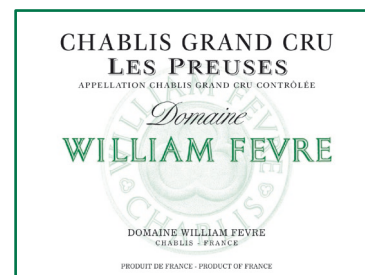
High toned with lots of acidity. A bit more body than the Preuses and impressive green fruit on the finish. A good wine for food whereas the more delicate Preuses could be drunk without food. Juicy. Really gets the saliva flowing!



Grand Cru Les Preuses Domaine 2020

17+ Points

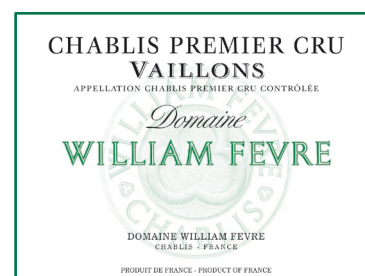
Light nose. Delicate texture. More elegant than some of its tablemates. Impressively long and smoother-textured. Still unformed but very promising. Classic.



Premier Cru Vaillons Domaine 2020

16.5+ Points

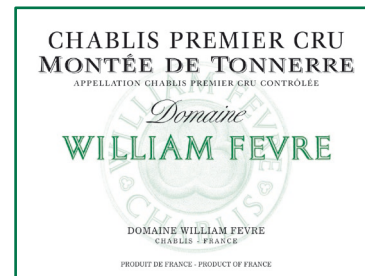
Greenish straw. Introvert nose and strong lime flavours on the palate. Clean, crisp but perhaps just a tiny bit broader than absolutely classic Chablis. Still a little bit astringent on the finish.



Premier Cru Montée de Tonnerre Domaine 2020

16.5++ Points

Pretty firm and full on the nose. Needs quite a bit of time. Lots of impact on the palate with real precision – seems like a well-etched statue. Still youthful but with enough juice and an appetizingly dry finish.



Chablis Domaine 2020

16 Points

Seems a bit more appealing and crisp than the sample tasted at chez Goedhuis. But still a bit appley rather than stony. Good acidity. If I saw this on a not-very-good wine list, I'd be happy to order it.
