Zena Crown Pinot Noir 2019

94 Points

Finesse meets structure, with expressive cherry and blueberry flavors that take on notes of orange peel, stony minerality and dusky spice, building momentum toward polished tannins.

Beaux Frères Vineyard Pinot Noir 2019

94 Points

Taut with tension, this slowly unwinds with complex cherry and guava flavors that are laced with notes of fresh tarragon and hints of river stone, building richness toward medium-grained tannins.

The Upper Terrace Pinot Noir 2019

94 Points

Sleek and dynamic, with vibrant raspberry and strawberry flavors that pull in accents of fresh violet, smoky spice and a dash of tarragon. Builds intensity and layers as it glides toward fine-grained tannins.

The Belles Soeurs Pinot Noir 2019

94 Points

A wine that uncoils patiently, with cherry and blueberry flavors laced with dusky spice, gathering speed and tension toward stony yet polished tannins.

Willamette Valley Pinot Noir 2019

94 Points

Vibrant and detailed, with impeccably structured raspberry and guava flavors that are laced with orange peel and black tea notes, building richness and sleek polish on the long finish.

Willamette Valley Chardonnay 2019

93 Points

Refined and sleekly complex, with citrus and pear flavors joined by lemon verbena and fresh ginger accents, which build steely complexity on a snappy finish.
